ALIENATION OF PROPERTY BY MEANS OF AN UNSOLICITED BID

Notice is hereby given in terms of Section 21 of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act, 2000, (Act 32 of 2000 as amended) read together with Section 113 of the Local Government: Municipal Finance Management Act, 2003 (Act 56 of 2003) and Section 37 of the Council's Supply Chain Management Policy that the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality intends to alienate the Remainder of Portion 27 of the Middelburg Town and Townlands 287 JS measuring 500m² to Mrs Lizzy Ntuli for brick manufacturing purposes at an amount of R275.00 (Two Hundred and Seventy Five Rand) per month, excluding VAT.

The alienation of this portion of land is not open for competitive bidding because:
